Notes

1. Play before last date of round (Wednesday) to receive maximum bonus points and be eligible for round prizes.
2. Finals matches to be played simultaneously where possible and played by date indicated (unless an extension is granted by Match Committee). Week 1 and 2 of Finals may (in exceptional circumstances) be extended by a maximum 3 days and the Grand Final by 7 days. The decision to extend the date will rest with Match Committee.
3. All regular season rounds **MUST** be played before **Wednesday 15 Jul 2009** for teams to be eligible to compete in finals. Courses to be used may change at short notice.
4. Teams are to nominate their home course for potential use as a Grand Final course no later than round 10. Teams that qualify for both handicap and scratch finals may choose separate courses. A second selection maybe required in the event of a match with lady players. The Grand Final course will be chosen at random from three courses as selected by the top two ranked teams and the match committee. Should a course pick not be provided by one or both of the top two ranked teams by round 10, selections from other teams may be used.
5. Finals systems, and cut-off handicap for Nicklaus Division will be advised on completion of all regular season rounds. Note that some teams may move between handicap divisions on completion of the last round.
6. Teams should note that there might be some restrictions on courses available for selection or adjustment of tee levels used by men teams. Some courses used in Finals may require a composite layout to be used if versing teams with lady players.
7. On completion of the last regular season round teams should check The Cyber Bunker website for the finals draw. www.thecyberbunker.com.au and go to the Golfer Page. The Finals Draw is posted below other season draws. This draw will show opponents for the finals, handicaps, courses and the results as they occur.
