Competition Handicaps are determined by recording the scratch scores of the last 10 rounds. Handicaps are provided to allow teams to score 18 stableford points over 9 holes.

How is our handicap determined? New teams are required to submit at least 3 handicap rounds, (at member prices), to determine a starting handicap. Existing teams handicaps are determined after every new competition round, including finals. All teams handicaps may be adjusted after the first 3 rounds of the competition.
