

Australia's Best Indoor Putter – Rules

Number of Stations/Elimination Process: The number of stations will be determined by the total number of competitors and the number of players eliminated per station.

Mat/Club to be used. The main hitting mat is to be used for all shots. A golf putter must be used for all shots.

Shots not registering or phantom shots: If a shot does not register the shot will be re-hit. If during a practice swing contact is accidentally made with the ball and the shot is 'registered' the ball is considered to be in play. Should a phantom shot be registered, a re-hit will be given. Malfunctions as determined by the TCB staff member will be adjudicated at the time of the attempt.

Event Structure: As per separate instructions.

Categories: One category for all competitors.

Determining Winners in Tied Stations: In accordance with separate instructions.

Fees: Once only \$12 entry fee

Prizes: Cash Prizes 1st place. Other placings dependent upon number of entries.

Duration of event: Preliminary round will be held over a four to six week period. Final will be hosted over a single day/evening. Normally a Sunday Morning.

Results: The event results will be posted on The Cyber Bunker website: www.thecyberbunker.com.au via the Golfer page. The exact link will be advised. Results will also be emailed to competitors.

Eligibility: Open to all comers.

Mobile Phones: Mobile phones are to be switched off during the final.

Viewing/Practicing: Competitors will not be permitted to practice the putting stations. Competitors who are yet to compete in the event (preliminary round or final) will not be permitted to view other competitors attempts. In the event that a potential competitor views attempts by another player that potential competitor will be ineligible to enter the competition.
