Notes: A par 71 municipal course of majestic wide open beauty, Bountiful Ridge rests atop the mountains surrounding Salt Lake City. It is not a normal stop on the tour, but its wild setting, large tantalizing fairways and challenging greens provide an unaccustomed treat for the Pros. Scoring here can be low, but if

the greens are dry and hard, golfers beware. The sharp breaks and unusual elevations are treacherous. A poorly judged putt can cause misery and embarrassment as well as a ruined round. All three par-5's are reachable in two and a good majority of the par-4's are short. The 4th and 11th though, are comparatively difficult and are easily the hardest holes of each 9 holes. This picturesque little course is a welcome diversion from the tight formality of the regular tour.

Bountiful Golf Club, fairly short at less than 6,500 yards, is situated along the front of the Wasatch Mountains with equally stunning vistas of the mountains and the Salt Lake valley in Utah. The course plays to par 71 (35-36) but it's not until the final hole that the player reaches the signature hole, a 485-yard, par 5.

An old refrain by veterans at the course is that on nearly every green, the putt will "...break towards the lake." True or not, there is plenty of opportunity to test the theory on the substantially undulating greens.

Hole by hole descriptions

No1 Par 5

A longish hole to begin with. Your tee shot has to miss the gully and trees down the right and also the road that meanders around the course. Watch the ravine short and right as trees will force you sideways. The road down the left is OB unless you are wild left over the other side of the fence.

No2 Par 3

The prevailing wind and slope means this hole normally plays much shorter than the metreage.

No3 Par 4

Stay left off the tee here to avoid the tree/bushes that completely block shots at the green. Watch OB behind the green.

No4 Par 4

OB is left but well into the trees.



No5 Par 3

This is a tough par 3. This hole plays reasonably long and the green can be difficult with a ridge running diagonally through the green. Avoid the trees and then attempt to master a difficult putting surface. Par here is a good score.

No6 Par 4

A sharp dogleg left where judging the flight of the ball around the sharp corner, uphill and in the wind, to a shallow fairway demands perfect execution. Really this hole is pretty open just stay out of the trees on the dog leg.

No7 Par 4

Just a short hole but don't miss left. Plays a little blind off the tee. Pick your line carefully and enjoy a wide open fairway.

No8 Par 4

Work out if you want to bang this one to the front edge or leave yourself a full wedge to this short par 4. Very open hole that invites attacking the green. Bombs away.



No9 Par 4

Another short hole. The tee shot here can be a little awkward. Play for a left to right shot to avoid the small cluster of trees down the left. Take care through the fairway long right and behind the green. Avoid the OB and scoring should be low here.

No10 Par 4

This is just a short hole and invites the big hitters to take it on. The road (OB) right adds a dimension that must be respected. The trees left are dead but often the tee shot will come down off the bank if you're lucky. The hole runs parallel to No1 and the fairway slopes severely left to right. Play your tee shot down the left if you can.

No11 Par 4

The 11th offers another uphill drive to a dogleg right. If the drive is short or too far right reaching the green over the shaggy cedars in two is almost impossible. The putting green is treacherous especially with any right pin location. We have actually seen this green 5 and 6 putted.



No12 Par 4

Again the road is in play. Play down the right as the trees are dead left.

No13 Par 5

The road is the major problem here so something down the right is best here. Tough to reach in two here.

No14 Par 3

A chance to score here. A large green and not too much slope to deal with. This hole probably presents as the easiest par 3 and a chance to attack the pin.

No15 Par 4

Hit past the trees either side of the fairway and then stick it close.



No16 Par 3

Another straight forward par 3. Attack this one.

No17 Par 4

A chance to pick up a shot here.

No18 Par 5

The finishing hole, a Par-5 can be easily reached, but the approach is all carry over a deep ravine gully in the fairway and two deep grassy depressions. The two-tiered green is demonically tricky. Any putt from above the hole is in danger of rolling all the way off the green. There have been some dramatic finishes there. Check the pin location before you hit your approach.
