

# **Australian Indoor Golf Team Championships and Single Player Tournaments Nomination Form**

## ***The Cyber Bunker***

**What competitions are available?** You can nominate for 9 hole Teams Open, Junior (U17) or Ladies championships played over 12 rounds. There are also single player 18 hole tournaments played over 4 rounds (just like the PGA). Should there be insufficient numbers to run separate junior championships or tournaments, conditions are modified to allow play in open competitions (Junior rates/Tee position/options).

**Do I need to be a Member to compete?** Yes, but the only membership you need to buy is a Bronze Membership which is \$15 annually. On joining your first competition you will be automatically upgraded to a Silver Membership with all the associated benefits while you are active as a comp player.

**How do I enter?** You will need a team-mate for team championships, but otherwise just fill in your details on the reverse of this page. Submit in person or fax/post your nomination to The Cyber Bunker.

**Do I need to be a good golfer?** No, all team championships and single player tournaments have handicap divisions to provide an even the playing field. Even novice golfers can compete especially in team champs.

**How are handicaps determined?** New teams or players are required to submit at least 3 handicap rounds, (at member prices), to determine a starting handicap. New teams handicaps will be adjusted after the first 3 rounds of their first competition. Existing teams handicaps are re-evaluated at the beginning of each new competition by collating the last 10 rounds of comp play. For single player tournaments should insufficient handicap rounds be available handicaps will be adjusted after the first two rounds and in some cases players may only be eligible for the scratch division.

**What days/nights will we play?** Currently there is no need to commit to any particular day (except for finals). Rounds are played on a day/night convenient to you and your golfing partner during the fortnight of the comp round or tournament. For team championships, play against other teams starts at the semi final stage. Single player tournaments are played over a ten week period with the first round used to adjust handicaps.

**What format is used?** A two person Ambrose system is used for team championships, while stroke play is used for single player tournaments. For division two and three handicap divisions Stableford scoring will be applied.

**How is Stableford scoring worked out?** You or your team will take a certain number of strokes for each hole. Normal scoring, prior to applying a handicap, is based on 1 pt for a bogie, 2 pts for a par, 3 pts for a birdie and 4 for an eagle (etc). Applying a handicap potentially provides you with up to an additional 2 pts per hole. EG a team or player on a handicap of 18 would receive 1 point for every hole played, therefore a par would be worth 3 pts instead of 2. The points scored for all 9 holes (team champs) or 18 holes (single tournaments) are added to get your overall score. All subsequent bonus points (team champs only) are then added to determine your total score for the round. Bonus points (team champs only) are awarded for various achievements (see scoring system). A scratch division will be maintained in conjunction with the handicap division.

**How long does it take to play?** It generally takes approx 1 hour to play a round. If you choose to play with a second team or second player in the same booth, the time taken would be doubled.

**Qualifying for the Finals (team champs only):** Teams may qualify in both scratch and handicap divisions. Depending on finishing handicap teams will be divided into Nicklaus and Palmer divisions. Refer to Competition rules for formats of semi finals and finals.
