Australian Indoor Match Play Championships

Australian Indoor Match Play Championships. The draw and other details of the first ever Australian Indoor Match Play Championships have been finalised. The event was held at The Cyber Bunker during December 2007 through to March 2008. The event saw players placed in pools of 4 players for the initial pool stage and then entered the main draw where there was a maximum of 32 players competing for the ultimate

Format

All matches used the match play (handicap) format. Players were placed into pools of 4 players based on indoor handicap. Once in the main draw all games were elimination matches. All players played 3 x 9 holes pool games. The main draw consisted of 2 rounds, quarterfinals, semi finals and the grand final match. All main draw matches will be played simultaneously where possible. When this is not possible some matches maybe played separately. Depending upon numbers competing in each Match Play event, a minimum of 3 players from each pool move through to the main draw, however minimum of 32 players progress to the main draw stage. The lowest ranked players from all pools maybe eliminated at this stage. Depending on final numbers competing the pool stage may be used only to determine rankings for the main draw. A progressive table of all [player rankings](#) will be maintained until the end of all pool games. Once all pool games are played the main draw will be completed and players will be asked for suitable timings to play opponents. View the draw for updates on results and scheduled dates for matches. Individual Tournaments

The inaugural individual tournament was played during May and June 2005. Held at Pebble Beach with Net and Gross champions declared. The Australian Indoor Golf individual tournaments are now a regular feature The Cyber Bunker and consist of four rounds over 18 holes (just like the US PGA) to determine the Net Champions in Division 1 (18 handicap and below), Division 2 and a Ladies division. 2005 Championships: The inaugural NTP Championships were completed during March - April 2005. Apart from claiming the title of the ACT Indoor Golf NTP Champion players had a chance of winning prizes and a full set of Prosimmon Golf clubs for the first Hole in One during the championships. Supported by CADBURY SCHWEPPEES and for just \$3 each player has four shots to pepper the 99m 7th hole at Pebble Beach. The top 20 closest players qualify for the finals. In the Final Shootout players get another crack at the hole in one prize and ultimately the title of Australian

Congratulations to Mario Prpic who holed out during qualifying and walked away with the Prosimmon Clubs courtesy of Cadbury Schweppes, and also to Brad McCauley who produced a superb shot which ended up 20cm from the pin during the Final Shootout. Brad is now the inaugural ACT Indoor Golf NTP Champion. Stay tuned for the next NTP championships.

Courses

The Cyber Bunker has over 50 international courses to choose from so there is no shortage of variety. Play on the traditional golf courses like St Andrews in Scotland, it just doesn't get any more traditional than the home of golf. The challenge of St Andrews includes the deep and steep faced bunkers and of course the wind that will blow your ball sideways (turn the wind down for a lesser challenge). Turn the wind up to gale force if you want to take the ultimate challenge and play it under British Open conditions. After that take on some of the toughest courses on the US PGA tour and worldwide like Royal Melbourne or Oakmont plus other courses like Firestone, Pebble Beach, Pinehurst No2. The challenge does not get much stiffer. If you want to test yourself against the best in the world tee it up on the Championship tees and give it a rip. Compare your scores to those achieved by Tiger Woods during his win at Pebble Beach in the US open or perhaps Payne Stewart at Pinehurst in 1999. You might even want to get a group together and play match play or other Ryder and Presidents Cup match formats on courses used for these tournaments like The Belfry, Oakland Hills (2004) and Valderrama.
